

# Why injury? My journey through research, policy and implementation

Professor Rebecca Ivers is head of the newly renamed School of Population Health, UNSW Sydney. Formerly head of the injury division at the George Institute for Global Health, and recognised internationally for her expertise in injury prevention and trauma care, Professor Ivers has expertise in design and conduct of large observational studies and randomised trials. Her work has substantially improved understanding relating to the burden of and risk factors for injury in many countries and informed policies for improving safety and injury globally. Professor Ivers works closely with the World Health Organisation, represents UNSW at the UN Road Safety Collaboration, and was named Category Winner, Innovation in the Australian Financial Review and Westpac list of Australia's Top 100 Women of Influence in 2014.
